2020 SAG Portfolio Planning Process Summary

Provided by the SAG Facilitator to Request Feedback

Background: The objective of the SAG Portfolio Planning Process was to reach consensus on Illinois Energy Efficiency Portfolio Plans (EE Plans) for 2022-2025 prior to utilities filing Plans for approval with the Illinois Commerce Commission on or before March 1, 2021. Key steps to the Planning Process were held jointly from March to November 2020 with the IQ North and IQ South EE Advisory Committees (IQ Committees). Key Process Steps:

- 1. <u>Planning Process Kick-Off</u>: SAG Facilitator presented an overview of the Planning Process; utilities presented an overview of current EE Portfolios
 - March 10 and March 11 SAG meetings
- 2. <u>Energy Efficiency Ideas</u>: SAG and IQ Committee participants were invited to share Energy Efficiency Ideas for utilities to consider in developing the 2022-2025 EE Plans
 - Energy Efficiency Ideas were due April 27, 2020
 - Utilities and interested stakeholders reviewed ideas before presentations
 - Stakeholders presented EE Ideas on May 12, May 13 and June 3; the May 13 meeting was held jointly with the IQ Committees
 - Utilities responded to EE Ideas on <u>June 16</u> and <u>June 17</u>; the June 17 meeting was held jointly with the IQ Committees
- 3. **Draft Utility EE Plans:** Utilities presented draft EE Plans
 - October 26 and October 27 meetings, held jointly with the IQ Committees
- 4. <u>Initial Stakeholder Feedback on Draft Utility EE Plans</u>: Stakeholders were invited to share initial feedback on draft EE Plans
 - November 16 and November 17 SAG meetings, with the November 16 meeting held jointly with the IQ Committees
- 5. <u>Final Negotiations</u>: Final negotiations were held between individual utilities and non-financially interested stakeholders from December 2020 to February 2021
