Purpose of the Midstream-Upstream Working Group

Background:

- In recent EE Plan portfolios Illinois utilities have offered EE to both midstream networks (incentives going to equipment distributors and/or contractors) and upstream networks (incentives going to manufacturers or retailers).
- This Working Group will explore additional opportunities to move programs from a traditional downstream approach (incentives going directly to consumers or businesses) to a midstream or upstream program approach.

➤ To provide a forum to discuss midstream and upstream EE opportunities in preparation for utilities developing their 2022-2025 EE Plans

Working Group Goals

- 1. Research and identify midstream and/or upstream measure(s) that may allow utilities to claim higher electric savings at lower cost, in considering cumulative persisting savings goals required for Illinois electric utilities
- 2. Research and identify midstream and/or upstream measure(s) that may allow utilities to claim higher gas savings at lower cost
- Discuss the potential development of a statewide midstream/upstream pilot program and the ability to claim savings across all fuels
- 4. Discuss midstream/upstream planning for the next EE Plan portfolio (2022-2025)

2020 Focus: SAG Portfolio Planning Process

- Objective of SAG Portfolio Planning Process: To reach consensus on Illinois utility EE Plans for 2022-2025
 - Utilities are required to file EE Plans with the Commission for approval on or before March 1, 2021
 - This is a consensus-seeking process to discuss foundational issues to EE Plan development, including: budgets, Portfolio objectives, Program ideas, and Program design
- Midstream-Upstream Working Group Planning Process Topic:
 - Discuss midstream/upstream planning for the next EE Plan portfolio (2022-2025), including utility planning considerations and stakeholder ideas / utility feedback
 - Stakeholder "Energy Efficiency Ideas" are due by April 1
 - Ideas will be presented during the May 12-13 SAG meetings
 - A follow-up discussion on any midstream/upstream ideas will be held during the June Working Group meeting
