1. Introduction

This report presents the results of the impact evaluation of ComEd's Program Year 2019 (CY2019) slate of energy efficiency programs. It presents a summary of the energy and demand impacts for the portfolio and each program and some detail on measure-specific savings. CY2019 covers January 1, 2019 through December 31, 2019.

In CY2019, ComEd's portfolio included 42 programs, including 17 Business, 10 Residential, 11 Income Eligible, three Pilot, and one cross-cutting program, Voltage Optimization, as listed in Table 1-1.

This summary report contains savings from programs that ComEd can claim towards the CY2019 goals. Process evaluation findings and results of net-to-gross research are presented in separate reports.

Seven programs had carryover savings from measures sold or incented in program year 9 (PY9) and program year CY2018 that were installed in CY2019. The programs are Lighting Discounts, Lighting Discounts – IE, Business Instant Discounts, UIC-ERC Income Eligible Kits, Food Bank LED Distribution, Elementary Education Kits, and Small Business Kits.

This report includes 13 programs that ComEd implemented jointly or coordinated with Nicor Gas Company, Peoples Gas Light and Coke Company ("PGL") and North Shore Gas Company ("NSG").

2. Portfolio Savings

The evaluation calculated incremental annual savings and cumulative persisting annual savings (CPAS) from the ComEd CY2019 programs. Each is presented below.

2.1 Annual Savings

Table 2-1 summarizes the incremental energy and demand savings the ComEd portfolio achieved in CY2019, including both electric and gas savings (converted to kWh). According to Section 8-103B(b-25) of the Illinois Public Utilities Act, "In no event shall more than 10% of each year's applicable annual incremental goal as defined in paragraph (7) of subsection (g) of this Section be met through savings of fuels other than electricity." The terms and calculation approaches are defined in section 2.2.

Based on the same issue, the ratio of the net and verified gross savings shown in the table will not present an accurate ratio for the portfolio.

Table 2-2 summarizes savings from the sectors. In CY2019, ComEd's energy efficiency portfolio achieved 1,597,848 verified net MWh savings, with the Business programs achieving 891,644 verified net MWh, the Residential programs achieving 344,617 verified net MWh, the Income Eligible programs achieving 177,394 net MWh, the Pilot programs achieving 152 verified net MWh, and 184,042 net MWh savings from Voltage Optimization. The portfolio savings included 1,545,645 net MWh from funded measures in CY2019 and 52,203 net MWh savings from previously funded lighting measures, or carryover, funded in PY9 and CY2018 through the Lighting Discounts, Lighting Discounts – IE, Business Instant Discounts, UIC-ERC Income Eligible Kits, Food Bank LED Distribution, Elementary Education Kits, and Small Business Kits Programs and expected to be installed in CY2019.1




Figure 2-1. Annual Incremental Electric Savings by Sector

Overall, the Business programs realized 56% of the portfolio savings, the Residential programs contributed 22% of the total savings, followed by Income Eligible programs at 11%, Voltage Optimization at 11%, and Pilots with less than half percent (see Figure 2-1). Further detail on the savings by program is shown in subsequent sections.

¹ ComEd did not report ex ante carryover savings for any of the seven programs. All program reports with carryover show carryover in the verified gross and verified net savings in the CPAS tables and subsequent tables.

2.2 Cumulative Persisting Annual Savings (CPAS)

Per Section 8-103B of the Illinois Public Utilities Act, ComEd's energy efficiency goals are expressed in CPAS, which is the sum of the electric energy savings achieved in a given year from all measures installed in that year and in previous years, but no earlier than January 1, 2012, that are still operational and providing savings in that year.

ComEd's CPAS are formed of several parts: electricity savings, including reduction in water usage that produce secondary kWh savings from water supply and wastewater treatment, and other fuels' savings (gas savings in therms converted to kWh in 2019) that ComEd can claim toward their goal.

2.2.1 Gas Savings

The gas savings attributed to ComEd's programs are only those not claimed by the Illinois gas utilities so that there is no double-counting. Some of the gas savings are from programs jointly implemented with the gas utilities, and some are from ComEd-only programs that produce gas savings along with electric savings. According to Section 8-103B(b-25) of the Illinois Public Utilities Act, "In no event shall more than 10% of each year's applicable annual incremental goal as defined in paragraph (7) of subsection (g) of this Section be met through savings of fuels other than electricity." For CY2019, ComEd's savings target is 1,021,810 MWh and so ComEd can claim up to 102,181 MWh in gas savings.²

The Future Energy Jobs Act (FEJA) specifies that ComEd shall prioritize other fuels for the Income Eligible population first to the extent practicable, but can use other fuels from other sectors to achieve their target. To calculate the other fuels' savings (gas savings) eligible for claiming, the evaluation team

used a data set containing all measure-level savings, with associated sector and program flags. We sorted the measures from the Income Eligible programs to the top, then sorted by descending measure life³. We calculated cumulative savings from the top of the data set until the cumulative total reached the maximum ComEd can claim. Only those savings above that point were included in Table 2-5 below.

2.2.2 Legacy Savings

FEJA specifies legacy savings, which are cumulative persisting annual savings from energy efficiency measures implemented by ComEd from January 1, 2012 to December 31, 2017 that are still providing savings in the applicable year. The evaluation applied the deemed legacy savings of 4,087,238 MWh toward ComEd verified CPAS in CY2019.⁴

2.2.3 Historical Savings

FEJA requires that historical savings be included in CPAS. This means that the CPAS tables shown in this report include savings from measures installed in 2018 that have not reached the end of their EUL. It also means that the CPAS tables account for expiring savings. The evaluation applied the historical contribution to CPAS of 1,726,758 MWh (electric 1,632,437 MWh plus counted gas converted of 94,321 MWh) toward ComEd verified total CPAS in CY2019.

2.2.4 Expiring Savings

FEJA specifies that each year ComEd's programs must replace energy savings for measures that have reached the end of their measure lives before any progress towards achievement of its applicable annual incremental goal may be counted. The evaluation calculated incremental expiring savings using the following equation.

Equation 1. Incremental Expiring Savings

Incremental Expiring Savings = CPAS Y_{n-1} - CPAS Y_n

The grand total incremental expiring savings in CY2019 is estimated as CY2019 incremental expiring savings plus the legacy incremental expiring savings in CY2019 and historical expiring savings from CY2018, given a value of 604,628 MWh (in CY2019, there were no incremental expiring savings, but from legacy incremental expiring savings of 471,604 MWh, and historical incremental expiring savings⁵ of 133,023 MWh).

³ For 2019, Guidehouse identified some measures where it was possible to confirm the gas companies were not also claiming gas savings (e.g., gas companies purchase therms from ComEd on advanced thermostats, they did not claim gas savings on clothes washers, ductless mini-split heat pumps, and EMS). 2.2.5 Total Savings

As shown in Table 2-3 and the following tables, ComEd's CY2019 energy efficiency programs achieved total electric CPAS of 1,597,848 MWh. They achieved 7,278,424 therms of gas savings, which converts to 213,331 MWh.⁶ From those gas savings, ComEd can claim 102,181 MWh toward their annual incremental goal. Adding the current year electric savings to the allowable converted gas savings gives 1,700,029 MWh total savings.

Adding the legacy savings of 4,087,238 MWh and historical savings from CY2018, the grand total CY2019 CPAS that ComEd can claim is 7,514,026 MWh (which is 105% of the CPAS goal).

2.2.6 Applicable Annual Incremental Goal (AAIG)

Per FEJA,⁷ the AAIG is estimated as the difference between the statutory CPAS goal for the current year (CY2019) and the CPAS goal for the immediately preceding calendar year (2018). We calculate progress toward AAIG that ComEd achieved in CY2019 as the difference in verified CY2019 CPAS and the incremental expiring savings (both expiring legacy savings and post-2017 expiring programmatic savings).

Equation 2. Applicable Annual Incremental Goal (AAIG)

AAIG = CPAS Yn Goal - CPAS Yn-1 Goal

Equation 3. Applicable Annual Incremental Goal Achieved

Progress toward AAIG = CPAS Y_n - Incremental Expiring Savings Y_n

In CY2019, the AAIG is estimated as 1,021,810 MWh. The estimated progress toward goal that ComEd achieved is 1,095,402 MWh, which is the difference between the CPAS that ComEd can claim against their goal (1,700,029 MWh) and the grand total incremental expiring savings (604,628 MWh). The AAIG achieved as percent of goal is 107%.

2.3 Weighted Average Measure Life

Guidehouse calculated the weighted average measure life (WAML) for the CY2019 programs as 11.0 years excluding Voltage Optimization and 11.3 years including Voltage Optimization.

The equation to calculate the portfolio level WAML is shown in Equation 4 where the summation occurs across all programs with savings during CY2019, except for Voltage Optimization. The WAML calculation includes the electric-equivalent of the gas savings that ComEd can claim toward goal, as discussed in the previous section. It does not include all gas savings.



4. SAVINGS BY MEASURE

Lighting measures contributed the most energy and demand savings to the portfolio by a substantial margin as shown in the end-use type categories in Table 4-1, Table 4-2, and Figure 4-1. Lighting measures contributed 65% of the portfolio net electric savings in CY2019. The Voltage Optimization program follows with 12% of net electric savings, 4% from HVAC measures, 3% from Residential Behavior, and 16% from all other measures.



Table 4-3 shows the end use measure savings by magnitude of impact in the respective portfolio sector. Lighting measures contributed the majority at 74% of net energy savings in the business sector, 62% in the residential sector, 89% in the income eligible sector, and 49% from the pilot programs. Next is the behavioral programs which contributed 16% in the net energy savings in the residential sector. In additional to lighting, HVAC and shell measures contributed 28% and 20% respectively for the pilot programs.
