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May 31, 2023 Meeting

Process Reminder

- The Policy Manual update process kicked off in June 2022, when policy proposals were due
 - This is an opportunity to <u>collaborate</u> on EE policy development
 - One of SAG's "Guiding Principles" is to participate in consensus discussions in good faith
 - Compromise will be needed from all participants

Timing Reminder

- Progress is needed in order to finalize the Policy Manual for filing this summer
- There are several other SAG activities that will not take place until the Policy Manual is finalized:
 - Discussing metrics related to the IQ reporting principle policies (finalize by end of 2023)
 - Discussing GHG savings questions (finalize by end of 2023, or identify non-consensus issues)
 - Develop + finalize plan for 2024 SAG Portfolio Planning Process

Effective Dates

- Throughout the Policy Manual update process, participants have proposed a variety of effective dates for policies
 - For Policy Manual Version 2, there were two effective dates: January 1, 2020 and January 1, 2022 (the start of the next EE Plan)
 - Effective Date Options for the Version 3 process ->
 - January 1, 2024
 - January 1, 2026 (the start of the next EE Plan)
 - Other?
 - Effective dates need to be finalized before the Policy Manual is submitted to the ICC for approval
 - Goal is to agree on all policies + effective dates by end of June

Steps to Finalize the Policy Manual

June: Conclude policy discussions

- Discuss follow-up on any remaining open items by end of June
- Discuss whether any policy issues remain non-consensus, and whether a non-consensus comparison exhibit will be filed when the Policy Manual is submitted to the ICC for approval
- As policies reach "final draft" form, they are posted on the <u>Policy Manual Subcommittee</u> webpage policies highlighted in yellow in the Policy Tracker are considered "final draft"
- SAG Facilitator will incorporate redline edits for all "final draft" policies, to share with Writing Committee

July: Writing Committee / Attorney Review Meetings

- The purpose of convening a Policy Manual Writing Committee after policies are finalized, before filing the Policy Manual with the ICC, is to ensure final policy language has a consistent voice, "look and feel", and content, avoiding substantive edits
- Writing Committee is open to non-financially interested attorney participants and ICC Staff
- Final Policy Manual circulated to Subcommittee for "errors only" review
- August: File Policy Manual with ICC

June Meetings

- Policy Small Group Meeting IQ Policy Follow-up: Thurs. June 1 (2:30 4:30 pm)
 - Goal is to reach "final draft" agreement on remaining open IQ policies: 1) NTG for Disadvantaged Areas; 2) Diverse Contracting Reporting; and 3) Equity and Affordability Reporting
- SAG Equity Subcommittee / Joint IQ North and IQ South EE Committee Meeting: Wed. June 7 (9:30 am - 12:30 pm)
 - Introduce IQ policies that will be included in Policy Manual
 - Opportunity for written feedback after the meeting due by Wed. June 21
 - NOTE: The June 7th meeting depends on the outcome of the June 1st Policy Small Group meeting
- ▶ Policy Manual Subcommittee Meeting: Wed. June 21 (9:30 am 12:30 pm)
 - Follow-up from prior meetings
 - Discuss comments on administrative edits
 - Discuss process next steps, including whether a non-consensus comparison exhibit will be filed
- ▶ Policy Manual Subcommittee Meeting: Tues. June 27 (9:30 am 12:30 pm)
 - Discuss comments received from IQ Committee
 - Confirm final effective dates
 - Goal is for this to be a PENCILS DOWN meeting final Policy Manual discussion

Additional Open Items

- ► CPAS Goal Setting: This is a ComEd policy proposal small group met twice and is reviewing edited language
 - Next Step: This policy may not be included in Policy Manual, but will be finalized in the same timeframe (by end of June)
- Policy Manual Section 8 Edits: To follow-up on a Subcommittee discussion, a small group proposed edits to Policy Manual Section 8, to reflect "costs as costs and benefits as benefits"
 - Edits were circulated to the Subcommittee for review, with comments due Feb. 8th
 - Blacks in Green and Peoples Gas/North Shore Gas submitted comments; the Small Group is working to incorporate minor edits
 - Next Step: An updated redline with minor edits will be circulated to the Subcommittee soon for review/comment; follow-up in June 21 meeting, if needed
- Administrative Edits: There are several edits that are administrative / minor, listed in the Policy Tracker
 - Next Step: SAG Facilitator will incorporate in redline and circulate for review soon; follow-up in June 21 meeting, if needed

May 31 Policy Topics

Background on Renewable Energy Policy

- Guidehouse policy proposal allowing renewable measures under EE programs
- This policy question was first presented to the SAG Evaluation Working Group in summer 2021
- A memo was circulated to SAG for comments in November 2021
- SAG Facilitator recommended waiting until the Policy Manual process to discuss finalizing the policy
- During today's meeting: Guidehouse will present an updated version of the policy proposal

Background on Nicor Gas Electrification Proposals

- Nicor Gas presented two electrification policy proposals, discussed at the January and February meetings
 - Interested Subcommittee participants shared written feedback on electrification proposals following the January meeting
 - Following the February meeting, Nicor Gas agreed to consider feedback, including whether to propose higher level policies
 - During today's meeting: Nicor Gas will present higher level policy proposals on electrification bill impact calculations and electrification savings verification
- Joint stakeholders proposed a policy on interactive effects between measures
 - The stakeholder proposal was discussed in October, with follow-up discussion in Nov., Dec. and Jan. - following the Jan. meeting, the policy was labeled "final draft"
 - During today's meeting: Nicor Gas will present additional edits

Background on ICC Staff Prohibited Expenses Proposal

- "Prohibited Expenses" is an existing Policy Manual policy
- ► ICC Staff submitted several proposed edits to the Prohibited Expenses policy in June 2022, as one of the policies to be considered in the Policy Manual update process
- One of the proposed edits is an issue in an open docket (incentive compensation), therefore will not be discussed in this Policy Manual process
- During today's meeting: ICC Staff is proposing an updated version of the policy proposal regarding edits to the Prohibited Expenses policy
