Nicor Gas 2019 Progression Chart





Nicor Gas 2019 Therm Savings



B.E.E.R/Business Custom Q3 – Q4 Progression








IQ Program Spending Progression

To be eligible, you:

- Must be a Nicor Gas customer at or below 250% of poverty level
- Must not have received direct install measures within the last 5 years

Target and Goal

- Earn incentives for improved envelope construction and the installation of energyefficient equipment.
- Nicor Gas provides incentives to builders who construct homes that include the installation of energy efficient equipment and may earn additional incentives for exceeding State of Illinois Energy Code requirements for duct and air sealing.

Requirements

- Duct sealing → 2cfm/100sf (or better)
- Air sealing → 2.5 ACH50 (or better)
- High-efficiency, sealed combustion natural gas furnace or boiler → 95 AFUE (or greater efficiency)
- Power-vent natural gas storage tank water heater
- Advanced thermostat
 - Any "smart" or "learning" thermostat, including, but not restricted to those manufactured by Ecobee, Emerson, Google, Honeywell, iDevices, Johnson Controls, Lux and Nest

Business Program Updates



- Strategic Energy Management
 - There will be two Cohorts in 2020 (both coordinated w/ ComEd)
 - 1) Alumni (customers continuing from cohorts from previous years; and
 - 2) a new public sector 1st year.
- B.E.E.R./ Small Business/ Business Custom
 - Will continue with an increased \$2 to \$4 pipe insulation rebate
