

 - Process/NTG: Q1-Q3 2021
 - TRM, Research, Reporting: Active now through Q3 2021
- 3. <u>Program Year 2021</u>: Drafting evaluation plans for work that will begin mid-year 2021 and wrap up in 2022
 - Impact Evaluation: Interim Reviews Q3 2021, End of Year Q1-Q2 2022

Annual Impact Reporting

- Joint Reports Draft reports by March 15, final reports by April 30
- Non-Joint Reports Best efforts to produce finals by April 30, complete in Q2
- Verify Adjustable Savings Goals updated accurately in December and January

Interim Impact Reporting

- Begin interim analysis and reporting for TRM-based programs when data is ready – June/July to September
- Conduct custom project sampling and verification when there is a sufficient number of completed projects
 - Our preference is to sample projects prior to end of year
 - Core C&I and PS custom programs generally sampled Q3, Q4
 - Some programs sampled quarterly (RCx) or as a census when projects are complete (Small Bus custom, MF custom)

Program-Level Research – Income Qualified

- 1. Completed in 2020 with 2019/2020 Participants
 - Multi-Family Income Eligible Kits distribution: satisfaction and in-service rates
 - IEMS Multi-Family Property Owner/Manager Survey
- 2. Impact Evaluation with 2020 and 2021 Participants
 - TRM-Based Program Savings
 - Custom Project Savings
- 3. Process Research with 2020 Participants, Occurring in Q1 2021
 - Income Eligible MF IHWAP Property Owner/Manager Survey
 - Income Eligible SF IHWAP Participant Survey
- 4. Other Research in 2021 and 2022
 - Cooperating with ComEd survey that will attempt to estimate participant NEIs

Program-Level Research – Pilots, Market Transformation


- 1. Evaluate pilot and market transformation efforts when proposed or launched if savings will be claimed
- 2. Limited involvement in Market Transformation at this stage
 - Participate in TRM Market Transformation framework development
 - Observe the initial planning stages of market transformation initiatives
- 3. In 2020 and 2021, Commercial Food Service impacts are evaluated under a resource acquisition framework
- 4. Participant feedback on Virtual Delivery and Installation effort in Home Energy Jumpstart (2021 participants)
- 5. Provide impact evaluation technical support to PGL and NSG on unique custom projects and TRM work-papers

COORDINATION ACROSS UTILITIES

- 1. Guidehouse coordinates with the other utilities and their evaluation teams on an ongoing basis this includes Ameren, ComEd, and Nicor Gas
- 2. Coordination beyond specific programs occurs as follows
 - □ SAG meetings on specific topics and issue management
 - Illinois-wide issues that may impact multiple utility programs
 - Illinois NTG Framework and Protocol Working Group
 - Illinois TRM Technical Advisory Committee
 - Coordination calls (monthly)
- 3. Gas/Electric Joint Program Evaluations (with ComEd evaluation team)
 - □ Some evaluations are done jointly (Non-Res NC, RCx, EEE, Income Qualified)
 - Joint programs are evaluated separately in some cases
- 4. Support Coordination on Research Studies
 - TRM measure research considered on a case-by-case basis



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
