This memorandum provides a summary of evaluation team activities and expenditures in Q4 of 2020 as stipulated in our evaluation contract. The team conducted these activities in in support of AIC's 2018-2021 Portfolio of Electric and Gas Energy Efficiency Programs.

Overview of Evaluation Activities

Key Activities for Q4 2020

In the fourth quarter of 2020, the evaluation team focused on continuing 2020 evaluation activities, including continuing analysis and reporting for a number of NTG research efforts, and finalizing early impact reviews for the majority of AlC's prescriptive energy efficiency programs. The evaluation team also developed draft 2021 evaluation plans, discussed them with AlC, presented them to SAG, and submitted draft written plans for AlC and SAG feedback. Additional items of note included:

- Beginning research for pilot evaluations of Efficient Choice (Enervee) and Virtual Commissioning (Power TakeOff)
- Continuing Building Operator Certification Research
- Reviewing AlC's 2021 gas savings goals as part of the adjustable savings goal process
- Finalizing societal NEI analysis and continuing to move forward with utility and participant NEI activities
- Participating in SAG and TAC meetings as needed

Upcoming Activities for Q1 2021

In the first quarter of 2021, the evaluation team will focus on development of draft 2020 impact evaluation reports. The evaluation team will also finalize 2021 evaluation plans.

Additional items of note will include:

- Fielding Instant Incentives participant survey with a focus on NTG updates
- Finalizing review of AIC 2021 gas savings goals
- Preparing 2020 cost-effectiveness inputs
- Participating in SAG and TAC meetings as needed
