### Working Group Background

- Two Phases:
  - ▶ Phase 1 May to August 2019: Reach agreement on the Framework for Estimating Market Transformation Savings Whitepaper, to be included in IL-TRM Version 8.0.
    - ► Final Framework: <u>Attachment C to IL-TRM Version 8.0: Framework for Counting Market Transformation Savings in Illinois (August 23, 2019)</u>
  - ▶ Phase 2 November 2019 to ongoing: Discuss MT business plans and savings protocols for utility MT initiatives.

### Working Group Purpose

- To provide a forum to discuss policy issues related to MT savings evaluation and estimation.
- ► To provide an opportunity to review specific MT initiatives and the data/approach proposed to be used to develop savings, including but not limited to:
  - Logic Models;
  - Savings/unit;
  - Total market unit data collection;
  - Natural market baseline data and projections;
  - Service territory accounting; and
  - The duration of any MT savings credit.
- ► To reach consensus on savings protocols for MT initiatives that may be included in the IL-TRM.

#### Proposed Schedule for 2020

- Quarterly Working Group meetings, with additional meetings scheduled as needed.
- If more than 2-3 topics require discussion at a quarterly meeting, the meeting will be held in-person instead of by teleconference.

  - ▶ Discuss strawman IL-TRM Template for MT Savings Protocols
  - Deeper Dive into open MT policy questions
  - Follow-up discussion on evaluation for potential future Code program
  - ▶ Utility update on MT initiatives from Midwest MT Collaborative are there any new MT initiatives being pursued in 2020?
